Student Count by Pell Eligibility



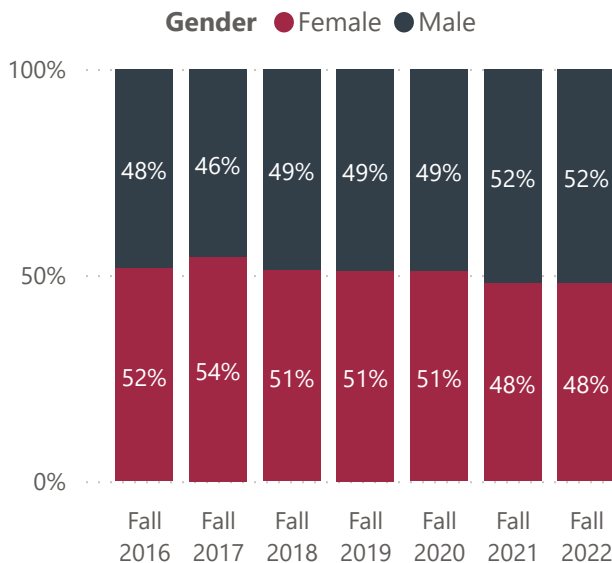

Top 5 States by Enrollment

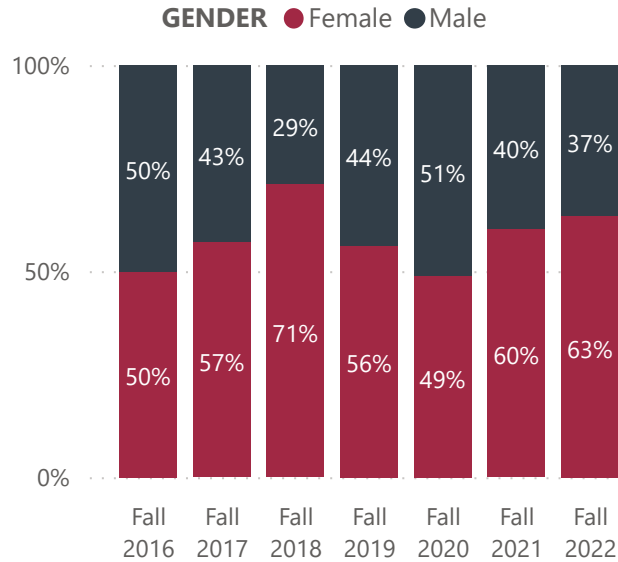

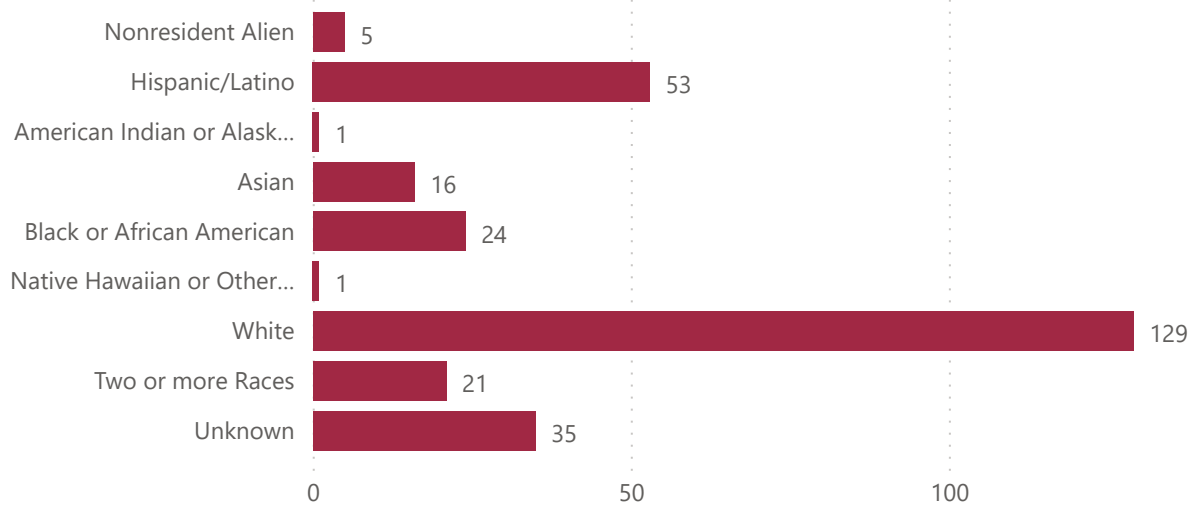

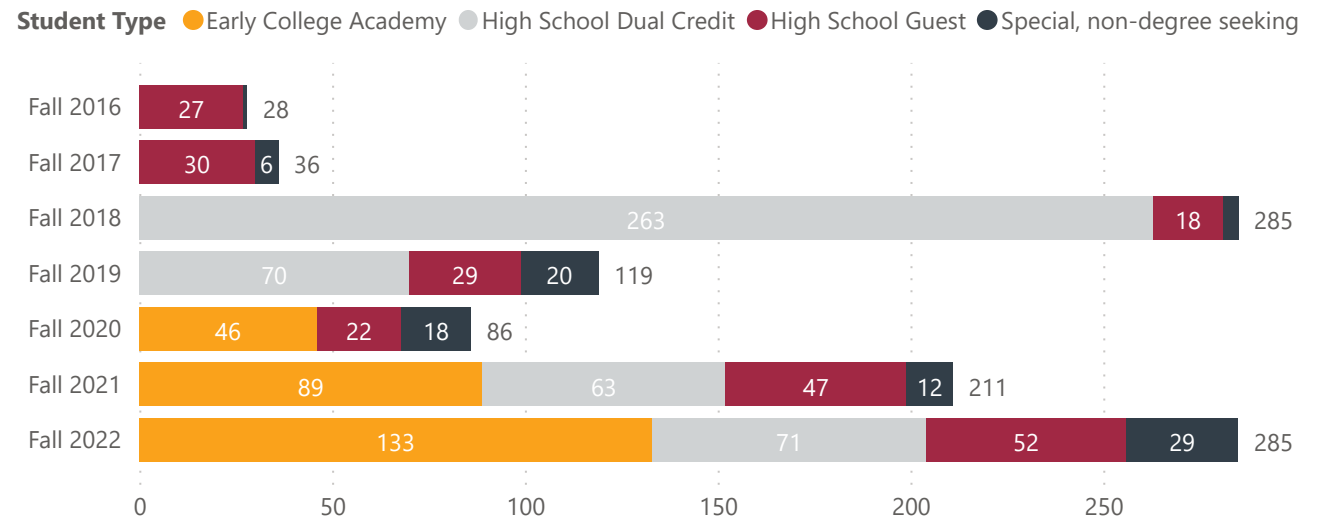

Fall 2022 Student Count by Ethnicity



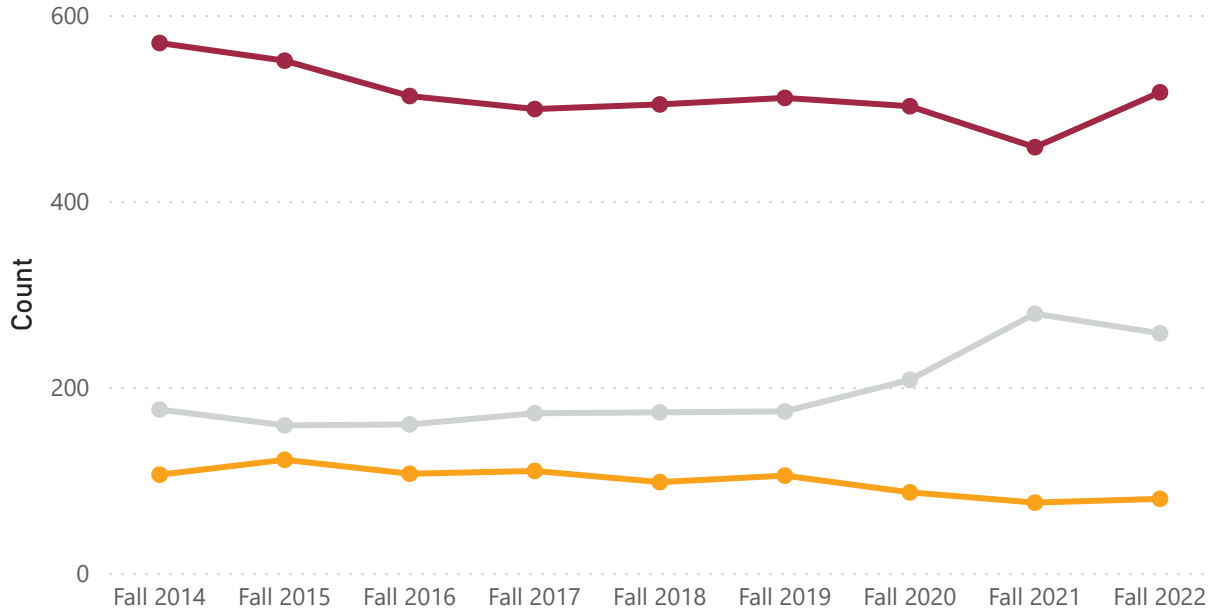

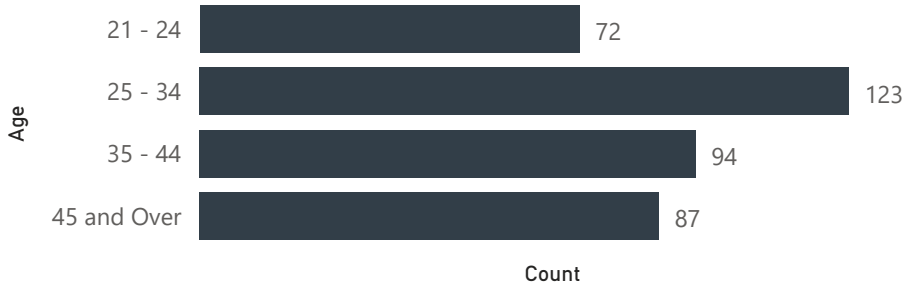

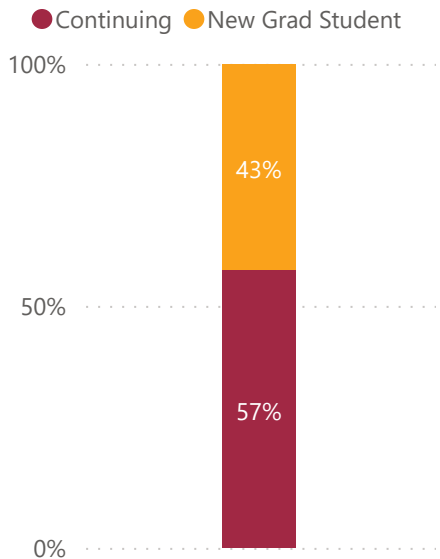

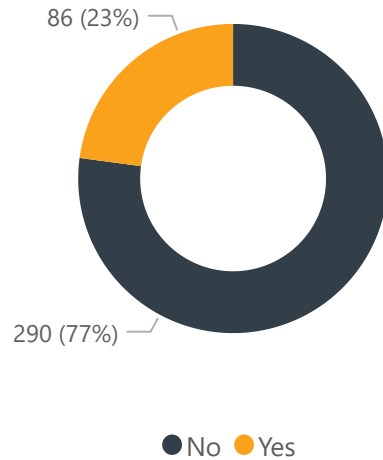
Count by Pell Offered Bins



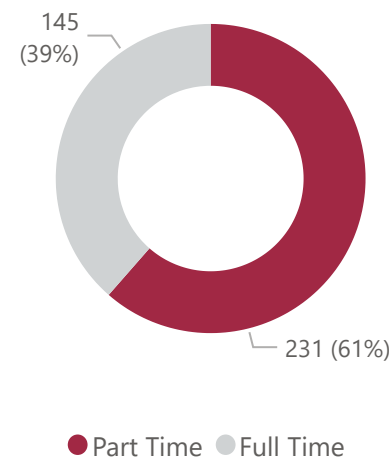
