The Department of Veteran's Affairs (VA) did not confirm that you are or will be a qualifying veteran for the 2010-2011 school year.

A Veteran is defined as someone:

- Who has engaged in active service in the U.S. Armed Forces (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or Coast Guard); or was a cadet or midshipman at one of the service academies or was a member of the National Guard or Reserves called to active duty for purposes other than training; and
- Who was released under a condition other than dishonorable.

You are not considered a qualifying veteran if you:

- Never served in the U. S. Armed Forces;
- Are currently an ROTC student;
- Are currently a cadet or midshipman at a service academy;
- Are currently a National Guard or Reserves enlistee and are activated for training only; or
- Are currently serving in the U. S. Armed Forces and will continue to serve through June 30, 2011.
