Transfer to Friends University

Friends University provides a clear transition for transfer students to pursue a baccalaureate degree.

2+2 transfer students from Butler Community College must have:

- Earned an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.) degree.
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Applied for admission to Friends University.

Students meeting the above requirements will:

- Be guaranteed admission to Friends University with completion of application requirements and receipt of transcripts.
- Enter the College of Business, Arts, Sciences and Education (CBASE) at a junior status toward a bachelor's degree.
- Be guaranteed to transfer all credits (100 level and higher) up to but not exceeding 64 credits from a two-year college with an earned grade of a C or better.
- Automatically qualify for an academic scholarship relative to the student's cumulative GPA. Scholarship offerings are subject to change. Students can inquire about academic and participation scholarships, financial aid, and grants by contacting the Friends University Financial Aid Office (316-295-5200).

For graduation from Friends University, students will need to fulfill all Friends University general education requirements, degree requirements and must meet all requirements for graduation as outlined by Friends University.
