







**Division of Business and Information Technology**





### CBASE Degrees by Major 2008 & 2009 Division of Education





**Division of Fine Arts**





**Division of Religion and Humanities**





**Division of Social and Behavioral Science**





**Division of Natural Science and Mathematics**





Liberal Studies**







A single deficit is not cause for concern if problem is understood and remedies are underway.  
 Indicates possible short-term borrowing and struggling to find reserves for reinvestment.
